



# VOCATIONS: ASSESSMENT

## BUILDING UP THE CHURCH PUZZLE

The good things that people in various vocations do help the Church, the world, and the mission of Jesus. Some help in big ways, and some help in little ways, but they all count. For this project, think about the different things that people do in religious life, the priesthood, and marriage.

### MAKE YOUR OWN PUZZLE

Design a puzzle where each piece of the puzzle has an action from a vocation that builds up the church.

#### DIRECTIONS:

Consider doing a rough draft of this project on scrap paper first.

Find a thick piece of paper to use for your puzzle. It should be thick enough so that if you write on one side the writing cannot be seen very well on the other side. Some ideas for paper include: card stock, construction paper, or 2 pieces of computer paper glued together.

On the paper, draw and color a picture of the Church. This will be the front of the puzzle.

On the back of the paper, draw light lines where you want the puzzle pieces to be. There should be 8,9 or 10 pieces.

In each piece, write an action that a priest, married person, or consecrated religious person would do that builds up the Church. An action by a priest, for example, could be “prays the Liturgy of the Hours,” or “celebrates Mass.” Include at least 2 actions from each of the 3 vocations.

Cut the paper into puzzle pieces.

Write your name on a little bag, box, or envelope, and put your puzzle in it.
